Input

Input consists of several Roman numbers, as explained in the exercise **problem://problemsjutge.org:problem-romans-1.pbm**. Every number ends in a period.

Output

For each Roman number, print its value.

Sample input 1

```
I.  
IV.  
X.  
XL.  
XLI.  
XVI.  
MMDCCVIII.  
CMXCIX.  
MMMV.
```

Sample output 1

```
I = 1  
IV = 4  
X = 10  
XL = 40  
XLI = 41  
XVI = 16  
MMDCCVIII = 2708  
CMXCIX = 999  
MMMV = 3005
```
