The  $n$  first lines of multiplication table of a natural number  $n$  are given by  $n$  multiplied by one, two, three, ..., until  $n$ . For instance, being  $n = 5$  we have  $5 \times 1 = 5$ ,  $5 \times 2 = 10$ ,  $5 \times 3 = 15$ ,  $5 \times 4 = 20$ ,  $5 \times 5 = 25$ .

Your task is to write a program that reads a natural number  $n$  and prints the  $n$  first lines of its multiplication table.

**Input**

The input is a natural number  $n$ .

**Output**

Your program must print the  $n$  first lines of the multiplication table of  $n$ , following the format of the instances.

**Sample input 1**

5

**Sample output 1**

```
5 x 1 = 5
5 x 2 = 10
5 x 3 = 15
5 x 4 = 20
5 x 5 = 25
```

**Sample input 2**

1

**Sample output 2**

```
1 x 1 = 1
```

**Sample input 3**

0

**Sample output 3****Sample input 4**

10

**Sample output 4**

```
10 x 1 = 10
10 x 2 = 20
10 x 3 = 30
10 x 4 = 40
10 x 5 = 50
10 x 6 = 60
10 x 7 = 70
10 x 8 = 80
10 x 9 = 90
10 x 10 = 100
```
