Write a function *next_word_list(w, f)* that given a nonempty string *w* and a list of strings *f*, returns the list formed by the strings in *f* that appear just after each occurrence of *w* in *f*. The order of appearance of the words in the resulting lists must preserve the original order.

Sample session

```
>>> next_word_list('red', ['red', 'yellow', 'red', 'black', 'grey', 'red'])
['yellow', 'black']
>>> next_word_list('big', ['small', 'big'])
[]
>>> next_word_list('big', ['big', 'small'])
['small']
>>> next_word_list('blue', ['green'])
[]
>>> next_word_list('blue', [])
[]
>>> next_word_list('red', ['red', 'red', 'red'])
['red', 'red']
```
